Going Mobile

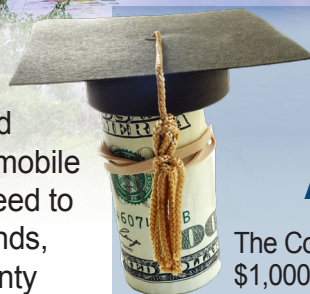

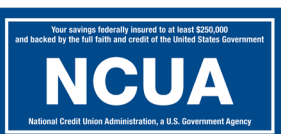
